## **Ramzi Jammal, MBA, MSc, BSc**

Ramzi Jammal has worked for the CNSC since 1998, holding progressively senior positions. He has accumulated over 35 years of experience in the nuclear industry, combining management skills with scientific expertise, and representing the CNSC in various international activities. These include the development and establishment of the IAEA Code of Conduct for the Safety and Security of Radioactive Sources, and the international categorization of radioactive sources.

He also played a key role in ensuring that the recommendations of the International Commission on Radiation Protection complemented the CNSC's regulatory needs. He sits on the Commission on Safety Standards; he led recent Integrated Regulatory Review Service (IRRS) missions to Russia in 2013 and India in 2015; co-chaired the IAEA Working Group responsible for drafting the first technical volume on the Background and Context of the Accident as part of the IAEA Fukushima Daiichi Accident report. He was elected as the President of the Convention on Nuclear Safety, 7<sup>th</sup> Review Meeting.
